Ohio's CLFC Master Trainers Speak Out

As mentioned in the Spring CLFC Newsletter, over the last 24 months, the Resilient Futures Network (RFN) implemented a statewide rollout of the *CLFC Curriculum Series* across Ohio in the Children of Incarcerated Parents Project. Under the direction of Ohio Mental Health and Addiction Services (OhioMHAS) and working together with the statewide Urban Minority Alcohol Drug Outreach Program (UMADAOP) Federation, RFN conducted CLFC Implementation and Certification Trainings in 6 host cities across Ohio (Toledo, Cincinnati, Mansfield, Akron, Cleveland and Cincinnati). Everyone who attended the trainings in Ohio demonstrated impressive personal motivation, teamwork and a prowess for accelerated skills acquisition. Preliminary results from these CLFC trainings were highly positive:

- 88% of trainees reported that they either Strongly Agree (70%) or Agree (18%) that they would recommend this training to others
- 100% of trainees reported that the information they received was either Very Useful (86%) or Useful (14%)
- 100% of trainees reported Yes (100%) that they agree with the CLFC Philosophy
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

Project with youth housed in the Louisville Metro Youth Detention Services (LMYDS). Response from

both youth participating in CLFC programming and youth workers at LMYDS has been highly positive.

participate in CLFC programs in LMYDS to learn the CLFC Program and key facilitation skills to share

with other youth in the community with the aim of possibly developing an ongoing mentorship program.
