

Dates Announced for Upcoming Opportunity to Receive CLFC Master Trainer Certification (September 16-20th, 2019)

A Few Full and Partial Scholarships Are Available

We are excited to announce the opportunity for previously certified CLFC Implementation Trainers to participate in a 5-day *Creating Lasting Family Connections (CLFC) Master Trainer Training* at our headquarters in beautiful Lousiville, Kentucky from September 16-20th, 2019. Several full and partial scholarships are available to qualified applicants.

Only previously certified *CLFC Original Program* or *CLFC Fatherhood Program* Implementation Trainers are eligible to participate. Certified CLFC Master Trainers will be qualified to train other professionals or volunteers within their own organization to implement the CLFC program.

Further, anyone receiving certification as a CLFC Master Trainer may also be eligible to receive paid contracts, plus travel and per diem expenses from Resilient Futures Network and/or COPES Inc. to train others outside of their own agencies. All certified Master Trainers will be expected to coordinate all CLFC training through the COPES office so that their participants can receive certification and be placed on our national registry of Certified CLFC Implementers. The cost for the 5-day training is \$2500. per person. (Several full and partial scholarships are still available to qualified applicants).
